- Location: E.N. Jenckes Store Museum, 283 Main Street, Douglas, Massachusetts, 01516-
- **Hours:** Saturdays, 9am to 12pm on the following dates:
 - o June: 17th
 - o July: 15th, 22nd, 29th
 - o August: 5th, 12th, 19th, 26th
 - o September: 9th, 16th, 23rd, 30th
 - October: 14th and 21st

All vendors are expected to be set up and ready for business by 9am sharp and remain set up for the complete 3 hours till the end of the market at 12pm.

- Vendor Fees:
 - \$170 Season pass every market
 - o \$90 Bi-weekly every other week
 - \$70 Pick 5 any 5 markets
 - \$45 Artisan Package any 3 markets
 - o \$20 One-day pass 1 market
- **Payments:** All payments and applications should mailed to:

- **Host:** The Douglas Historical Society hosts the Farmers Market. Fees and proceeds go back into running the market and toward the Society for the upkeep of the historically significant E.N. Jenckes Store Museum and to educate the public about the history of Douglas.
- **Volunteers:** Society volunteers are on site of the market for both vendor and customer support. There will also be a docent inside the Museum available to give tours of the store so feel free to send folks inside.
- **Restrooms:** There is one bathroom inside available for your convenience. It is not open to the public.
- **Parking:** There is no on-site parking. You are welcome to unload your vehicle curbside. A market volunteer will direct you where to park.
- **Tables:** The Jenckes Store has folding tables and chairs available upon request prior to market day.
- **Weather:** In the event of rain, we plan to move our vendors inside. This will depend on the severity of the weather. The committee will access the situation and inform vendors as soon as possible.
- Vendor Products: This is a farmers market and priority is given to locally grown, raised, or handmade
 products that fit the markets mission. Please do not sell other products without speaking to the
 market manager first.
- **Certifications:** You are expected to be in compliance with any applicable licenses and all Board of Health regulations. If you are not, you will be asked to leave immediately.
- **Trash:** Vendors are responsible for their own trash.
